Tell us about your organisation or business

We are a community-led youth organisation delivering creative arts programs for Aboriginal youth aged 12 - 18 in our region.

We:

- Run weekly after-school art workshops
- Provide a safe and culturally supportive space
- Work with local artists and Elders
- Support young people to build confidence and connection

Our programs help young people:

- Stay engaged in positive activities
- Build creative skills
- Strengthen cultural identity

We currently have strong demand and regularly reach capacity in our sessions.

How long have you been operating?

Funding Activity

What will you do with this funding?

We will:

- Add a second weekly workshop session
- Purchase additional art materials and equipment
- Engage a second facilitator to support delivery

This directly supports growth by increasing the number of sessions we can run and allowing more young people to participate.

What will increase or improve in your organisation as a result of this funding?

We want to support more young people and improve our program access. To do this we want to:

- Increase sessions from 1 to 2 per week
- Increase participant numbers from 15 to 30 young people per week
- Improve program consistency with an additional facilitator
- Reduce our current waitlist



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What challenge or opportunity will this funding help address?

We currently have more young people wanting to attend than we can accommodate. We don't have enough materials and we need to hire the venue we are currently using more often for more sessions

Funding will allow us to meet demand and expand safely.

- Participants will build confidence, skills and social connection
- Increased participation in positive activities
